

Beyer Hall Pool Policies

Recreation Services welcomes you to Beyer Hall Pool. In an effort to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for our patrons, your observance of the following rules is appreciated.

- Please be aware that participation in all Recreation Services programs is voluntary, and use of these facilities involves a level of risk. Participants are encouraged to have a physical examination prior to participating in any activity and maintain their own medical and health coverage.
- Spirited participation is encouraged, however; please refrain from inappropriate behavior and the use of profanity.
- Priority usage is designated for ISU students, faculty & staff during open hours.
- Do not enter the pool unless a lifeguard or qualified instructor is present.
- Only "Lap Swimming" is allowed in Beyer Pool (Aqua Jogging is allowed in the Diving Well).
- No diving into the lanes or in other areas marked, "NO DIVING".
- No running on the deck or pool enclosure area.
- No horseplay in or around the swimming pool.
- No back dives, back flips or front flips allowed.
- Swimming lessons in the pool are prohibited.
- Use of diving boards, starting blocks and trampoline are prohibited during informal, recreational swim.
- Use of the swimming pool by anyone with contagious disease or open sore is prohibited.
- Please remove all band-aids before entering the water.
- No food, gum, tobacco or beverages allowed in the swimming pool or pool area.
- Do not swim after the consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- Lane lines, handicap chair, time clock, radio and other pool equipment are to be handled only by the lifeguard staff.
- For your convenience, swimming lanes are designated Fast, Medium, and Slow. Please choose a lane according to your ability. Lifeguards reserve the right to move patrons if necessary.
- Please notify the Building Supervisors (515-294-2466) of any needs you may have, unsafe activities or facility problems immediately. Call ISU Police (515-294-4428) if it is an emergency.
- Patrons may be billed for late, damaged or lost equipment. Removing equipment from the facility is not permitted.
- Intramurals, Sport Clubs, Campus Organizations, University Affiliations and groups with advanced reservations approved through the Recreation Services scheduling office have priority over all other groups.
- Animals are not permitted in facilities except, trained service animals.
- Patrons should report missing items to the respective facility supervisor as soon as the items are noticed missing. Recreation Services is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.
- Non Coast Guard approved flotation devices are prohibited. These include but are not limited to; water rings, water wings, unapproved lifejackets and inner tubes.
- Toys (such as balls, rafts, Frisbees, etc.) and other items are prohibited.
- Decisions rendered by the lifeguard staff are final.
- All Beyer Pool patrons are expected to be responsible, courteous and safety conscious at all times.
- Violations of Beyer Pool rules, Recreation Services program policies, or ISU student conduct policies, may lead to removal from the facility and loss of privileges. This includes use of false identification.

Lap Swimming Etiquette

For the health and enjoyment of all swimmers, please abide by the following:

- Expect to share a lane. If there are 3 or more swimmers, you must circle swim.
- Try to swim with others of your own pace.
- Swim in a counterclockwise direction staying on the right side of the lane.
- Pass only when the passing lane (middle of lane) is clear.
- Avoid congregating at the end walls. Please move to the extreme right corners of the lane if stopping for a moment.
- Be considerate of others and their individual workouts.
