  - Comments on this
    - Motorcycle also got stuck with fines from 2 years ago
    - Bass Anglers: When they started they knew the past club had a debt. They were under the impression that they had no one associated with that club and the name change; with that debt they don't have any money.
    - Campus Org changed their mind and decided to charge them anyway for their debt.
    - Judo: The debt was from their missed meetings.
    - Shotokan: Since they are a new club, is there any way to petition to accounting. Is there a way to pay off debt in increments? Or take part of their debt away.
    - Mike Harvey: \$275 is the debt
    - GSB is willing to loan money to organizations to take care of debt.
    - Broomball: It seems that the responsibility is on SCC.
    - Motorcycle: When they went to correct their situation, they were told they are trying to catch clubs "trying" to change names.
    - Mountaineering: Thinks it is unfair to stick them with the debt. He thinks SCC should just pay for the debt.
    - Crew: is there a bylaw anywhere that says a club must pay off their fines before they fold.
    - Flying Cyclones: seems like Campus Org is drawing an arbitrary line.
      - Motion to forgiving the fine. 2<sup>nd</sup> from Shotokan.
    - Motorcycle: Show big is the SCC budget. That would come out of the SCC Exec and our budget is \$500.
    - IMAGE: They are confused about debt. Debt accumulated over 2004-2005 school year.

    - Probably not a good idea to have everyone there. Probably a good idea to write a letter or send a representative.
    - Shotokan: we need to look at those options and talk to Campus Accounting. We need to see if GSB has any alternatives.
    - Flying Cyclones withdraw previous motion
    - New motion: SCC work with Bass Anglers and Campus Org to resolve this issue with the debt. Then in Spring to figure this out. 2<sup>nd</sup> from Tennis. In favor: UC, non-opposed.
