I just wanted to thank all of you that have submitted times for your clubs practice in Lied during the cold, dark months of winter. Like last year, we have a lot of clubs that want time/space indoors, so we will do our best to accommodate all of your needs the best we can. I realize this isnt the maximum amount of time you all want; however, we have to accommodate the rest of the ISU community as well.

Since the debt retirement on Lied is being paid for with student fee monies, it is requested by the GSB that we keep Lied available for drop-in recreation for all students as much as possible during the academic year. Keeping this in mind, we are willing to do all we can to help get you some practice time, although it may not be the ideal situation for you, we are trying to work with you to ensure you have at least some space and time to practice. In the past, this was not always considered; however, Recreation Services current philosophy is that we believe your clubs should have some designated space and time to practice.

Here is what I have scheduled based on your requests. We will begin this schedule on Monday, October 23 and it will continue until Thursday, March 8. **SHOULD YOU NOT WISH TO BEGIN THIS SOON OR GO THIS LONG, PLEASE LET ME KNOW. IF THEY DONT HAVE A LIED USER PASS, THEY WILL NEED TO PAY \$6.00 EACH TIME THEY COME TO THE FACILITY OR THEY WILL NEED TO PURCHASE A LIED WEEKLY, MONTHLY, SEMESTER OR ANNUAL USER PASS.
